WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Title Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 970-16 passed August 10, 2016 is hereby amended to read as follows:

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of the Department of Community Development to enter into agreement with the Buckeye Shaker Square Development Corporation for the Eleven Angels Community Garden Project through the use of Wards 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 Casino Revenue Funds

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of Community Development is hereby authorized to enter into agreement with the Buckeye Shaker Square Development Corporation for the Eleven Angels Community Garden Project for the public purpose of promoting community green space and beautification in the city of Cleveland through the use of Wards 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 Casino Revenue Funds

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$12,800 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188.

Section 2. That the Title Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 970-16 passed August 10, 2016 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of Community Development is authorized to enter into agreement effective September 1, 2016 with the Boy Scouts of America, Greater Cleveland for the Boy Scout Outreach Program for the public purpose of teaching and engaging young male youth residing in the city of Cleveland about scouting activities in the Boy Scout Organization through the use of Wards 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 8 Casino Revenue Funds.

WHEREAS, a leak has been detected in an underground high-pressure steam line at the north end of Public Hall on East 6th Street; and

WHEREAS, the steam line has been shut off affecting heat to a portion of Public Hall; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the underground steam line be replaced immediately, in advance of winter temperatures; and

WHEREAS, Cleveland Thermal, LLC has been the City's contractor for this type of work in the past and is capable of performing this work immediately at an estimated cost of \$87,268; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council authorizes and approves a contract by and between the City of Cleveland and Cleveland Thermal, LLC in the estimated amount of \$87,268 to make the emergency repair to an underground high-pressure steam line at the north end of Public Hall on East 6th Street and any related equipment.

Section 2. That the cost of the contract authorized shall be paid from Fund Nos. 10 SF 035 and 20 SF 562, RQS 7005, RL 2016-115.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
