Withdrawing objection to the renewal of a D5 and D6 Liquor Permit at 4703 Pearl Road, 1st floor and basement and repealing Resolution No. 975-16 objecting to said renewal.

WHEREAS, this Council objected to the renewal of a D5 and D6 Liquor Permit to Mandy's Lounge, Inc., DBA Mandy's, 4703 Pearl Road, 1st floor and basement, Cleveland, Ohio 44109, Permanent Number 5476818 by Resolution No. 975-16, adopted by the Council on August 10, 2016; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to withdraw its objection to the above permit and consents to said permit; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That objection to the renewal of a D5 and D6 Liquor Permit to Mandy's Lounge, Inc., DBA Mandy's, 4703 Pearl Road, 1st floor and basement, Cleveland, Ohio 44109, Permanent Number 5476818, be and the same is hereby withdrawn and Resolution No. 975-16, containing such objection, be and the same is hereby repealed and that this Council consents to the immediate permit thereof.

Section 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Amending the Title and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1361-16, passed November 14, 2016, as it pertains to authorizing the Director of the Department of Community Development to enter into agreement with Boy Scouts of America, Greater Cleveland Council for the Boy Scout Outreach Program through the use of Wards 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 17 Casino Revenue Funds.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Title and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1361-16 passed November 14, 2016 is hereby amended to read as follows:

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of the Department of Community Development to enter into agreement with Boy Scouts of America, Greater Cleveland Council for the Boy Scout Outreach Program through the use of Wards 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 17 Casino Revenue Funds.

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of Community Development is authorized to enter into agreement effective September 1, 2016 with the Boy Scouts of America, Greater Cleveland for the Boy Scout Outreach Program for the public purpose of teaching and engaging young male youth residing in the city of Cleveland about scouting activities in the Boy Scout Organization through the use of Wards 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 17 Casino Revenue Funds.

Section 2. That the Title and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1361-16 passed November 14, 2016 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
