### **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:**

**Section 1.** That the Director of the Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement effective September 23, 2016 with Union Miles Development Corporation for the Preventing Violence and Healthy Solutions Project for the public purpose of providing educational programs on violence prevention and the impact that this has on improving the public health of city of Cleveland neighborhoods through the use of Ward 2 Casino Revenue Funds.

**Section 2.** That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$15,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188.

**Section 3.** That the Director of Law shall prepare and approve said contract and that the contract shall contain such terms and provisions as he deems necessary to protect the City's interest.

**Section 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
